

CCU RESIDENCE HALL DESCRIPTIONS

CCU is an alcohol-free, smoke-free, & drug-free campus

ALUMNI HALL

- Room measurements: 12'9"X 11'3" (actual available floor space is smaller with bed, desks, etc.)
- Window measurements are: length 38" X width 68 ½ "
- Three student apartments are located in the building (primarily for upperclassmen)
- Desks are attached along one wall and bookshelves are mounted above them
- Each room includes 2 extra-long twin beds

RESTORATION HALL

- Room measurements: 14' X 12'10" (actual available floor space is smaller with bed, desks, etc.)
- Window measurements: length 48" X width 64"
- A limited number of single rooms are available on a first come, first serve basis
- Each room includes 2 extra-long twin beds
- Prayer rooms are located on the 1st and 3rd floors

DECORATIONS

- Room decorations are encouraged, so long as they do not create health/ and or fire hazards, cause damage to the room, or are deemed contrary to the mission on the University.
- Christmas decorations are not to include live trees (artificial trees are acceptable).
- CCU reserves the right to remove or alter any window, wall or door postings inside or outside of the room that is deemed offensive.
- PAINTING IS NOT PERMITTED! If a student paints any area of their room, the residents of the room will be responsible for paying the Facilities Management to repaint the room (\$250.00).

INFORMATION CONCERNING BOTH HALLS

- Vending machines are located in the lounge
- Use of laundry facilities in each dormitory are free of charge
- Each building has a Resident Director who is a CCU employee and lives on campus. The RD's have responsibility for the day-to-day oversight of the residence halls.
- Each floor of wing is assigned a student to serve as a Resident Assistant. The RA is an employee of CCU and is responsible for developing the atmosphere on the floor.
- Each floor has one restroom and one shower for all of the students to share.
- School owned microwave ovens are provided in each residence hall
- School owned furniture may NOT be removed from the dorm without permission from the Resident Assistant.
- Beds provided in each room may NOT be removed. Removing a bed will result in a \$100 fine and the bed will then be placed back into the room.

WHAT YOU NEED FOR THE DORMS

NECESSARY DORM ROOM ITEMS

- Desk lamp
- Waste basket
- Laundry bag or hampers
- Laundry detergent
- Sheets
- Pillow and pillow case
- Blankets, bedspread
- Alarm clock
- Bath soap, shampoo
- Wash cloth, towels
- Small bucket or container (to carry items to the shower)
- School supplies (pen, paper, stapler, etc.)
- Cleaning supplies (window cleaner, room deodorizer, etc.)
- Extension cord (heavy capacity- 14 gauge min.)
- Power strip with surge protector

OPTIONAL DORM ROOM ITEMS

- Computer and printer (on-campus computer labs are available for students)
- Small refrigerator
- Can/bottle opener
- Glass, cup, bowl, plate, silverware
- Iron
- Aspirin, medicine, bandages
- Stationery
- Posters, calendars
- White Plasti-Tak (removable adhesive)
- Throw rug or carpet
- Radio, stereo, TV (cable ready)
- Small coffee table
- Floor pillow
- Reference books
- Filing cabinet/file folder box
- Non-Wireless Routers (Wireless routers NOT permitted)

FIRE SAFETY

All of these items are NOT permitted in the residence halls due to the potential fire hazard.

- **COOKING SUPPLIES** This would include, but it not limited to: toasters, electric skillet, crock pots, hot pots, George Forman Grills, coffee pots, popcorn poppers, hot plates, fry pans, fry pots, counter-top ovens, sandwich makers, or personal microwave ovens.
- **CANDLES & INCENSE** This includes, but is not limited to: gel candles, candles, potpourri crocks and incense.
- **CEILING FANS/AIR CONDITIONERS** Students may not install ceiling fans or air conditioners for safety reasons and because the residence halls cannot take the energy drain from such appliances. Any personal maintenance that involves tapping into pre-existing electrical, water or phone systems is prohibited for personal protection.
- **EXTENSION CORDS/MULTI-PLUG ADAPTERS** For the protection of the residential community, each resident is permitted to have only 1 extension cord and power strip combination. Only UL approved three prong grounded extension cords that are 14 gauge are permitted. Cords cannot exceed 10ft. in length. Only UL approved multi-plugged power strips with circuit breakers are permitted. The combination of the extension cord and power strip may not exceed 14ft. due to fire code restrictions.

INTERNET/WI-FI

- Wireless routers are NOT permitted. Only non-wireless routers will be allowed in dorm rooms. There will be one port for an Ethernet jack in each dorm room. In addition, campus Wi-Fi coverage will extend to the residence halls.
