Catalog Course Description

A course required of those who test below the acceptable level for ENGL 110. Class sessions involve discussion of grammar principles and completion of printed and computerized exercises.

Additional Course Description

This year, Basic English has been separated into two aspects. The first is an intensive, one-week session, which will be followed by lab requirements throughout the semester. The Basic English Intensive will provide focused instruction guided

practice to prepare students for English 110. In the course, students will participate in group sessions, individual work, and at home assignments. This course is focused on bringing students up to speed with the skills they need to succeed in ENG 110.

Grading and Attendance

ENGL 011 Intensive is a Pass/Fail course. Students must complete all in-class assignments and nightly homework in order to pass.

Attendance is vital to success in this course. Students who miss more than two sessions of the course will receive a failing grade.
